JUDGE CHRISTINE MIELE'S WRITTEN CRITIQUE

As you know the show was dedicated to the memory of Bob Cox. Bob was a good friend of mine. We were both Presidents of our respective National Clubs at the same time and had many discussions on how we could work together to benefit the memberships. We spent many hours figuring out how to include the Canadian titles in our yearbooks and how to try and get the GR News to you as inexpensively as possible. Bob had a large personality and an even larger heart. He loved life and his beloved Golden Retrievers. It was an honor for me to judge this show in his memory. Overall the entry showed great depth of quality. There were a fair number of dogs with good front assemblies. In the entire entry I only saw one or two bites that were so-so - most had good scissor bites with full dentition. There were a number of dogs who were short on leg and that is something that we need to be careful to avoid. Several exhibits were otherwise balanced but too close to the ground. The one fault that I saw the most often was wide set shoulder blades. I feel that is the reason why the dogs had so much excess movement in front. There were a handful of dogs who moved close in the rear. The dog classes were superior to the bitch classes. The bitch classes had a wide variety of heads. There was a large assortment of faults in the head outlines ranging from Roman noses, to weak underjaws, to extreme facial cowlicks to very short muzzles. We need to keep in mind that the proper length of muzzle is needed for the Golden to pick up game birds. A muzzle that is too short, while it gives a "cute" teddy bear quality to the face, is neither correct nor functional. The cowlicks take away from the kind expression that is essential in the Golden and make an otherwise pleasant face, harsh with furrows.

The senior Puppy Dog class.

1. 244 (Armband) **De La Framboisière Cluso** had a very pleasant head. I would have liked to see a longer rib cage. Overall length to height proportion was good but the rib cage did not carry over 2/3 of the back.

2. 153 **Musedor My Peter Pan Victor** was very sloped in the croup which made for a difficult rear movement. Coat texture was too soft.

3. 411 **Ambleside Backus At Otterslide** was probably my favorite in the class. There was a change of handlers and the dog became concerned about his surroundings. While it is certainly understandable for a boy dog to go through these periods, it has to be reflected in the placements. He shows great promise once he regains his confidence.

12-18 Male 1. 260 **Albanor Full O'The Spirit** has a lovely working back, good foot timing and nice reach. A pleasure to judge.

Canadian Bred 2. 368 **Goldylock Butch Good Boy** This dog was down in the rear pastern which threw off his movement significantly. He could also stand to lose some weight.

Bred By Exhibitor 1. 470 **Trowsnest Tanglewood Andre** had one of the best coat textures of the entire entry. The forechest was very good and filled my hand.

2. 332 **Weiland's It's Bean A Blast** This dog was lacking in "moderate". There was too much coat and not proper texture. Movement was choppy and short-strided.

Open dog Class. This class as a whole had exceptional depth and was a joy to judge. I am pleased to say that I know the sires of three out of the four placements and am very encouraged that they have contributed to such nice quality.

1. 322 **Rockywoods Almost Heaven** exhibited excellent foot timing. When he moved I saw perfect balance from front to rear. He had a lovely, masculine head, well developed, an excellent tight coat that jacketed his body perfectly. His ribcage extended well back and he carried his topline through the turns. He was of excellent type and he never put a foot down wrong.

2. **166 Skylon Sir Champlain** Also a lovely dog who could do better with some conditioning. He had a roll over his shoulder when standing but had a lovely head, strong body and solid movement.

3. **412 Ambleside Adam, CGN** A good exhibit but longer in body than the 1st and 2nd place dogs and looking not quite as mature as the two dogs in front.

4. **483 Summerbay's Aint 2 Proud 2 Beg** Had more angles behind than in front so on the down and back he crabbed and came at you wide to compensate for the imbalance. I know the father of this dog took many years to mature.

Veteran male was absent.

Junior Puppy Bitch

1. **429 Goldriver Indian Manjubala** This young girl was very balanced and athletic. She was very clean on the down and back.

2. **450 Goldensand Lethal Seduction** Was one of the bitches with a short muzzle. She was short on leg so the 50% length from the ground to the elbow and the elbow to the tip of the shoulder blades was not there causing her to roll.

Senior Puppy Bitch

1. **369 De La Framboisière Chan** Had a very nice length of leg and exhibited very good reach in front. It will be good to see her develop as she matures. She shows great promise.

2. **271 Camelot's From Here To Goldhaven** is longer in body than the 1st place dog and did not have as much forechest.

3. **440 De La Framboisière Kira** had a significant topline roll. The coat was difficult to judge because it stood away from the body.

12-18 month bitch This class had excellent type throughout and was very competitive.

1. **201 Majesty When Jake Met April** was a lovely cream bitch. Beautiful foot timing and forechest. Her tailset was slightly low but not significant given her overall strength of type. She was under serious consideration for winners bitch and reserve but she let down in the winners class.

2. **167 Superbe Brooklyn Des Savanes** also excellent type but carrying excess weight which impacted her movement.

3. **421 Edelweiss On Your Mark GetSetGo** and 4. **453 Regency Northern Alliance** were very similar bitches both with nice type, pleasing expression but both were short on leg.

Open Bitches.

1. **192 Majesty Unlike Anyone** had the same sire as the 12-18 month bitch. She has an outstanding coat, very tight and a good outline. She had very nice rear angles and balanced movement. She moved clean coming and going and had a look of intelligence in her eyes.

2. **331 Weiland's Just Push Play** has a nice layback, better than the first placed bitch but was shorter on leg. That caused more bounce in her movement than the first place dog. Still had lovely type.

3. **569 Mjaerumhogda's Kari Av Norsehaven** was out of coat and could have a more pleasing head. She was clean in her movement but did not have the outline of the first and second place.

4. **148 Celebrations Grounds For Divorce** had a more upright shoulder causing her to have wide movement in front.

Winners bitch was the open bitch who truly used her rear in her movement, a lovely head, coat, and overall package. The 12-18 bitch was serious competition but she let down in the ring and was unable to hold her topline.

Veteran Bitches What a great class!

1. **512 CH Lazyriver Sweet Sasha, OD, SDHF, CGC, TDI** Where do you begin to describe such an outstanding example of the breed. Sasha even at age 11 has an effortless movement, perfect foot timing, strong topline. When you put your hands on her she still has excellent muscle tone and all the pieces are in the right place. For those who have the opportunity to see her compete, she will be a benchmark by which all other bitches are judged.

2. **160 Majesty's Voluptuous Lady** Also had outstanding type and was exceptional when stacked. The movement was also solid although not quite as effortless as the first place veteran.

3. **484 CH Freelin's Java Jolt, CDX, WC, RN, CGN** Another lovely veteran certainly deserving to be in this group of outstanding old ladies.

Specials Class At my first breed assignment in Canada, as a sweeps judge, Kathy Lorentzen gave Jerry Best of Breed. It was the first time I had seen him and was truly struck by how strong and powerful he was. For this show, it was a Jerry son out of a Shaynedoro bitch who prevailed. This is a credit to consistency in breeding.

239 CH Raplabgold Looking For Cash The Best of Breed dog had a strong masculine head with a pleasing expression, proper length of ear and correctly set on his head. He also had a strong underjaw to complete the lovely headpiece. He had an outstanding front assembly with a very nice shoulder layback and excellent foot timing. His ribcage extended well along his back allowing him to carry a faultless topline. When he stopped to free-bait he landed square with an equal distribution of weight on all four legs showing off his balance. He has a lovely flow of neck into shoulders. There was no excess fat and he was presented in excellent condition.

330 CH Goodtime's Sucre A La Creme The Best of Opposite bitch could do with a smaller ear but she possessed a lovely coat that protected the body and a pleasant feminine head and expression of intelligence. She was not a particularly large bitch but was balanced and athletic with a nice short coupling and lovely bend of stifle. She also carried her topline well and was able to show how secure she was on the free stack.

512 CH Lazyriver Sweet Sasha, OD, SDHF, CGC, TDI The **Award of Merit** went to Sasha who is certainly one of the great dogs that I shall remember forever.
